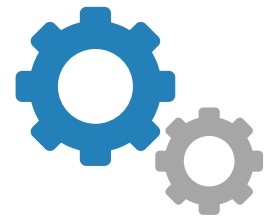

### STRUCTURE

- Available for K-8; Classroom of 20 students per grade level (Total of 7-8 classrooms)
- MSD15 has partnered with Northern Illinois University to recruit Teaching Interns from NIU's College of Education (classroom co-teaching model)
- 2 Research Interns (qualitative and quantitative)
- Students have a 2-hour day: 9:00-11:00
- 3 sessions during the 2021-2022 school year consisting of 10 Saturdays in Session 1, 10 Saturdays in Session 2 and 8 Saturdays in Session 3
